If you are looking for a specific type of mental health care provider, the Network Provider Directory at www.tricare-west.com can help.

TRICARE covers mental health care services, including those delivered through telehealth. Be sure to review referral and pre-authorization requirements for mental health care services at www.tricare.mil/mentalhealth before seeking care.

Searching the West Region Network Provider Directory

- 1. Go to the Network Provider Directory.
- 2. Click the circle next to "Health Care Providers" in the Search For section.
- 3. Enter your ZIP code and TRICARE plan in the Your Location Details section.
- 4. Choose "Behavioral Specialists" or "Hospital/Clinics/Others" from the "Type" drop-down menu in the *Provider Details* section.
- 5. You can filter further by choosing the type of mental health care provider under "Specialty" in the *Provider Details* section.
