



Submitting TRICARE® Authorization and Referral Requests

Understanding Beneficiary Types and TRICARE Plans

Active duty service members (ADSM)

- If enrolled in TRICARE Prime:
 ADSMs must obtain referrals and pre-authorization for all care outside of the military hospital or clinic, except for emergency services.
- If enrolled in TRICARE Prime Remote:
 ADSMs may be seen for civilian primary care
 without pre-authorization but need referrals and pre-authorization for all specialty care.

All others beneficiary types

- If enrolled in TRICARE Prime, TRICARE Prime Remote or TRICARE Young Adult – Prime: Referrals and preauthorization are required for most, but not all, specialty care.
- If enrolled in TRICARE Select, TRICARE Retired Reserve, TRICARE Reserve Select, or TRICARE Young Adult – Select: Referrals aren't required, but pre-authorization may be required for certain services.
- If enrolled in TRICARE For Life: Medicare is primary.

Verifying Approval Requirements

- Have you checked requirements? Use our Prior Authorization, Referral and Benefit tool.
- Is it an ancillary service, such as diagnostic radiology or lab tests? Use our Ancillary Services Requirement tool for approval requirements. Most ancillary services do not require a separate approval from Health Net Federal Services, LLC (HNFS).
- Is it a limited benefit? Check if we offer a Letter of Attestation you can attach instead of clinical documentation. This will expedite the review process!
- Will the service be rendered at a freestanding ambulatory surgery center (FASC)? Be sure to verify the procedure is on TRICARE's list of approved procedures that can be rendered at an FASC. (An FASC is a surgery center not attached to a hospital or owned by a hospital within a 35-mile radius.)

Accepting Military Providers' Electronic Signatures

If a service was referred by a military hospital or clinic and approved by HNFS, **HNFS' approval letter will serve as the signed order.**

- Our approval letter will include an electronic signature from the referring military provider.
- Look for the text, "This Referral is Electronically Signed by the Ordering Provider" at the end of the "Reason for Request" paragraph located on the first page of the letter. (Access copies of the letter through our Authorization Status tool.)
- Please do not request a separate order from the referring military provider. (**Note:** If you need additional clinical information, you may contact the referring provider.)

Beneficiary Costs/Fees

TRICARE updates beneficiary costs and fees each calendar year.

- ADSMs do not have out-of-pocket costs.
- Family member costs vary based on their sponsor's status and TRICARE health plan.

Provider Resources

Understanding the TRICARE West Region authorization and referral process is a big part of providing the best care for your TRICARE patients. Referrals are required for most specialty care under TRICARE Prime, while authorizations may be required for certain services under all TRICARE plans. Below are online resources you can use in your practice to help you avoid extra work for unnecessary requests or penalties (for network providers only) for services that require an approval.

Prior Authorization, Referral and Benefit (PARB) and Ancillary Services Approval Requirements Tools



The PARB tool allows you to easily determine HNFS' approval requirements, TRICARE benefit

Before submitting an authorization or referral request to HNFS, save yourself time by first checking to see if an approval is needed.
